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Official opening of the camping begins May 15th 2021 and ends October 2nd 2021. Trailers, tent trailers, RV's and tents should not be installed before that date and will need to be removed from the site before October 3rd 2021.

Each campsite allows a maximum of:

- 2 adults and 3 children's
- 2 vehicles
- 2 tents if there is no camper/RV on the campsite or one tent if there is

All other persons on the campsite are considered visitors and must register at the office and pay the appropriate fees.

NOTE: Anyone who rents a seasonal site is responsible for informing its visitors to show up at the reception, if this is not respected, the visitor's fees will be forwarded to the tenant of the site and they will have to pay the costs.

- All other vehicles which can't park on campsite must park in the visitor parking lot.
- No vehicles will be allowed to park on the road.

The following schedule must be respected:

- Departure of visitors is 10:30 pm
- Hours of tranquility (curfew) from11:00pm to 8:00am; Fires to be Extinguished by 1:00am
- On the day of departure, check out is at 12:00 (noon)

It is forbidden to:

- Behave in a manner that disturbs others (partying, vulgar language, etc.)
- Make excessive noise (loud radios, Motocycles, Dirt bike etc.)
- Have a fire anywhere other than the fire pits
- Cut wood from the park forests for any purpose including campfires
- To drive mopeds, motorcycles and all-terrain vehicles on the campsite to go take a shower or go
 to the bathroom, they can only be used for recreational purposes to leave the site and go to the
 trails.
- Weapons of any sort such as firearms, air guns, firecrackers, bows & arrows, slingshots or knives are strictly prohibited and will result in confiscation and or expulsion without refund.
- Possession, consumption or trafficking of drugs will result in immediate expulsion without refund.
- Sobriety is expected at all times on the campground. Alcohol may be consumed at yourcampsite
 only.
- All vehicles operating in the park must respect the speed limit of 5 km/hr.
- For safety reasons, glass bottles and containers are prohibited on the beach.
- Park users must dispose of garbage and waste in the designated area.
- Campers must keep their own site clean, which means no accumulation beer cases or other debris outside of their trailer
- Park users must participate in recycling.
- Pets are allowed on the campground but not on the beach. They must be on a leash or tied up at
 all times and their droppings must be collected and disposed of in the garbage, under penalty of
 fine and expulsion.
- Campers must be at least 18 years old to rent a campsite.
- Children under 12 years old must be accompanied by an adult when they are on the beach or playground because those areas are not supervised.
- At no time can a minor child be left unattended.
- Campers who break or destroy equipment through negligence must pay for its repair replacement. They will also be held responsible for damages caused by their visitors.
- The campers must report their arrival and departure at the reception staff.
- Do not take shortcuts through sites on foot, bicycle, ATV or other motorized vehicle.
- These rules are subject to modification by the management without notice.
- At no time are fireworks allowed on campsite or beach unless permission is granted by the Municipality.
- All campers on the campsite must respect the rules of the environment and not discharge sewage on campsite. The campground provides users the necessary equipment for each camper to dump wastewater in the septic located at the main entrance of the campsite.
- Anyone violating this rule will be fined and will be responsible for the cost to clean up the site

• All occupants and their guests are responsible for maintaining a well-groomed site, free from unsightly debris, clutter and combustible materials and to respect common areas (i.e. shower house, bathrooms, beach and boat launch).

No cutting or removal of trees or shrubs without management permission. Please do not put nails or sharp objects in trees.

- All occupants holding a permit will not sub-lease or rent their site.
- All occupants must at the end of the season remove campers and any other equipment (eg; refrigerator, BBQ, bicycles etc.) If these instructions are not followed the Municipality will dispose of without warning after closing date.
- Modifications to the landscape of a site, (i.e. walls, gravel, driveways, trees, etc.) will become the property of the management when the license to occupy is terminated
- All seasonal occupancy permit holders will be required to provide a non-refundable deposit of \$350.00 for the 2021 season before or by October 12th 2020, in order to retain their occupancy rights.
- All seasonal occupation permit holders will be required to give the balance of the 2021 season rental by 01 April 2021. Anyone not giving the final payment before the above date will lose the occupancy reservation as well as the initial deposit.
- All occupants who have not deposited before the deadline of October 12, 2020 will lose their right of occupancy for the 2021 season and will have to remove any structure serving as a deck or storage before October 14 2020
- All decks or other structures must not be attached to trailer and permission must be granted by municipality permission needed as well as for installation of storage sheds.

IMPORTANT NOTICE

- When there is a fire ban in dry weather only fireplaces conforming to the Sopfeu standard will be allowed and any other form of fire will not be allocated.
- We remind you that the use of all-terrain vehicles (ATVs) is permitted on the site, to go
 outside the site, transport of waste water tanks and not for recreational use on
 the site.
- During an electrical breakdown, the sanitary services, shower, toilet and laundry service will be out of use and that the main building will be locked for the duration of the breakdown period. We invite you to use your own installation.

FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THESE RULES WILL RESULT IN YOUR EXPULSION FROM THE CAMPGROUND

After two warnings one verbal and one written, the camper will be evicted from the campground without reimbursement for rental whether it be a rental for a day or the season.

Anyone who rents a site is responsible for their visitors to follow the rules. If there is failure to comply with the rules from them, the person responsible for the site will be penalize.
